

BARNESVILLE CITYWIDE CLEAN-UP WEEK APRIL 20, 21 & 22

SPECIAL GARBAGE AND SMALL AMOUNTS OF BUILDING DEBRIS PICK-UP. ALL MATERIAL MUST BE SET OUT BY 5 AM. NO ADDITIONAL TAGS ARE NEEDED FOR THIS SPECIAL CLEAN-UP WEEK.

WED. April 20: All residential customers who normally have their garbage collected on Wednesday.

THURS. April 21: All residential customers East of Front Street and North of and including 3rd Avenue SE

FRIDAY April 22: All residential customers East of Front St. and South of 3rd Ave. SE (excluding 3rd Ave. SE)

If time allows, the crew will work ahead of the schedule above, but will do the entire route on stated day & time.

Special YARD WASTE Pick-up for all areas on Friday, April 24 - Yard waste must be in a "clear plastic bag" or a clearly marked open container. Brush piles must be bundled so they are manageable for one person.

NO TIRE PICK-UP. Tires (off of rim) may be brought to the recycling center upon payment of a \$2.50 fee per tire.

NO Household Hazardous Waste - These materials can be taken to Clay County Shop on Highway 52, just outside Barnesville on Saturday, April 23 from 8 am to 12 Noon - Call 701.299.5077 with questions

APPLIANCES will be collected at your curb, AFTER payment of a \$20 fee at the recycling center, your name will be put on a list and appliances will be picked up throughout the week.

Regular Meeting • February 8, 2016**

Vice-Mayor Jason Rick called this regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Members present were Council members Jason Rick, Betty Strom, Don Goedtke, Larry Davis, Jr., and Brad Field. Absent was Mayor Eugene Prim and Council Member Dawn Stuvland.

02-08-16-01 Motion Davis, second Goedtke to approve the agenda as presented, with the addition of adding the appointment of Richard Sylvester to the Park Board. Motion carried.

02-08-16-02 Motion Davis, second Strom to approve the consent agenda as presented. Motion carried.

Council member Stuvland arrived at 7:05 p.m.

02-08-16-03 Motion Strom, second Goedtke to open the public hearing for the Housing and Community Development Needs and Citizen Participation Plan at 7:06 p.m.

02-08-16-04 Motion Strom, second Goedtke to close the public hearing for the Housing and Community Development Needs and Citizen Participation Plan at 7:16 p.m. Motion carried.

02-08-16-05 Motion Goedtke, second Strom to approve the Citizen Participation Plan for the City of Barnesville. Motion carried.

02-08-16-06 Motion Field, second Strom to approve a resolution Identifying Slum and Blighting Conditions. Voted aye: Rick, Goedtke, Strom, Davis, Stuvland, and Field. Voted nay: None. Motion carried.

02-08-16-07 Motion Strom, second Goedtke to approve a resolution authorizing Community Development Block Grant Application. Voted aye: Rick, Goedtke, Strom, Davis, Stuvland and Field. Voted nay: None. Motion carried.

02-08-16-08 Motion Field, second Davis to table the snow removal in the Commercial Park discussion to the March regular council meeting. Motion carried.

02-08-16-09 Motion Davis, second Goedtke to approve the 2nd reading of Ordinance 2016-01 regarding Off-Street parking of trailers and recreational vehicles in residential areas. Motion carried.

02-08-16-10 Motion Davis, second Field to approve the Summary Ordinance 2016-01. Motion carried.

02-08-16-11 Motion Strom, second Field to approve the amendment to the 2016 Budget, removing the \$30,000 tax revenue amount that was not included in the Levy Resolution from the budget for Debt Service Fund 315. Motion carried.

02-08-16-12 Motion Strom, second Stuvland to approve and authorize TEC Manager Guy Swenson to renew the NBCU 2016-2018 Affiliation Agreement through the NCTC. Motion carried.

02-08-16-13 Motion Field, second Strom to approve and authorize TEC Manager Guy Swenson to renew the FUSE 2016-2020 affiliation agreement through the NCTC. Motion carried.

02-08-16-14 Motion Strom, second Goedtke to approve and

authorize TEC Manager Guy Swenson to renew the AMC 2016-2021 affiliation agreement through the NCTC. Motion carried.

02-08-16-15 Motion Field, second Stuvland to approve a resolution increasing rates for Cable TV. Voted aye: Rick, Goedtke, Strom, Davis, Stuvland, and Field. Voted nay: none. Motion carried. Vice Mayor Rick adjourned the meeting at 7:41 p.m.

INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR BARNESVILLE MUNICIPAL TELEPHONE ACCOUNT

This notice is to inform you of FCC rules regarding Customer Proprietary Network Information (CPNI) data and how it is handled by telecommunication companies. CPNI is personal information collected by Barnesville Municipal Telephone for billing and provisioning service. Examples of protected information include call detail, services and features subscribed to, and carrier selected. Examples of non-protected information, include name, address, and phone number if published. Barnesville Municipal Telephone is doing everything possible to protect the privacy of your information. FCC rules require us to make sure it is YOU, anytime you call or come into the office and ask for protected information. The following procedures have been put into place to comply with FCC rules and protect you.

If you come into the office for information, please bring a copy of your complete bill with you. If you do not have your bill you will need to provide a valid photo ID before we can share info on your account.

If you are calling the office, you need to provide a PASSWORD to allow us to share information about your account. If you have already set up a password, no action is needed at this time. **If you have not already set up a password for your telephone account, we would strongly encourage you to complete the form below and return it along with your payment.**

Remember, that information will only be given to the name of the person(s) on the account, which is the name printed on your telephone bill. If you would like other people (husband, wife, family, etc.) to have access to the account and/or make changes, please list those names on the form. Remember that all contacts will need to provide a valid photo ID when they come into the office.
