

ATTENTION PET OWNER

As a pet owner within the City of Barnesville, there are certain responsibilities that will require your attention and cooperation:

- ❑ Your pet **must** be current on vaccinations.
- ❑ Your pet **must** be licensed with the City of Barnesville yearly and a license tag affixed to its collar.
- ❑ Your pet must be walked on a leash **not** to exceed 6 feet.
- ❑ Your pet is **not** allowed to run loose within the city at any time. Should your pet be left outside, it must be chained or restrained on your property.
- ❑ Female dogs in "heat" should **not** be chained or left outside without an owner present.
- ❑ Your animal is not allowed to defecate on any public or private property within the city (including city parks). Should an animal be taken for a walk, **you** are responsible to pick up any feces left by your pet.
- ❑ Your dog is not allowed to bark or cry continuously. If you are not home during the daytime, please leave the animal indoors.

Please accept these responsibilities as a pet owner and help make Barnesville a "Pet Friendly City" for all citizens.
