**Regular Meeting • July 10, 2017**

Mayor Prim called this regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Members present were Council members Don Goedtke, Jason Rick, David Brown, and Brad Field. Absent were council members Larry Davis Jr. and Betty Strom.

07-10-17-01 Motion Rick, second Goedtke to approve the agenda with the following additions: approval to hire Jared Hansen for the Public Works Maintenance I position, and a resolution for PERA Police officer declaration. Motion carried.

07-10-17-02 Motion Rick, second Goedtke to approve the consent agenda. Motion carried.

Council member Davis arrived at 7:15 p.m.

07-10-17-03 Motion Rick, second Davis to approve the bid from Dirt Dynamics in the amount of \$49,010.75 for the sewer repairs on 5th Ave. SE. Motion carried.

07-10-17-04 Motion Rick, second Davis to approve the petition for local improvements at 317 5th Street SE. Motion carried.

07-10-17-05 Motion Rick, second Goedtke to approve the 2nd reading of Ordinance 2017-05, an Ordinance regarding garage space requirements. Motion carried.

07-10-17-06 Motion Rick, second Goedtke to approve the Summary Ordinance 2017-05. Motion carried.

07-10-17-07 Motion Davis, second Rick to approve the 1st reading of Ordinance 2017-06, an Ordinance regarding keeping of animals and fowl. Motion carried.

07-10-17-08 Motion Rick, second Brown to approve the PERA Police Officer Declaration Resolution. Voted aye: Rick, Goedtke, Davis, Brown and Field. Absent: council member Strom. Motion carried.

Mayor Prim adjourned the meeting at 8:03 p.m.

## **EMT CLASS STARTS IN SEPTEMBER!**

Barnesville Ambulance will be hosting an EMT Class starting in mid-September and running to mid-December.

Plans are to meet on Tuesday and Thursday evenings from 6-10 pm. There will also be a couple of Saturday Skills labs.



Students will learn everything required to pass the National Registered EMT test

- Including CPR and AED Skills
- Oxygen and other medication administration
- Splinting and bandaging
- Caring for medical emergencies
- Mass Casualties and much more

The tuition is \$750; books are \$250 and the test fee is \$75.


If the student passes the National EMT exam, and works for Barnesville Ambulance for 1 year, they will be eligible for a \$600 reimbursement from the State of Minnesota.

EMT's taking call for Barnesville Ambulance enjoy serving their community in a way not many people can. EMT's are also eligible for continuing education credits, yearly clothing allowance, and a very flexible schedule. Volunteers are paid call pay, and run pay for each time they are paged out. This is a very rewarding and fulfilling way to help others.
