Mayor Prim called this regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Members present were Council members Jason Rick, Larry Davis, Jr. Betty Strom, David Brown, and Brad Field. Absent was Council member Don Goedtke

10-09-17-01 Motion Davis, second Strom to approve the agenda as presented with the addition of the approval of the gambling premise permit for the Barnesville Rod & Gun, and approval of the Joint Powers Agreement with Humboldt Township for 13th Street. Motion carried.

10-09-17-02 Motion Davis, second Brown to approve the consent agenda as presented. Motion carried.

10-09-17-03 Motion Field, second Davis to proceed with Option 3 for paving the parking lot at Friendship Park, which includes draining the entire parking lot to the North, through the alley as it does today at Friendship Park. Motion carried.

10-09-17-04 Motion Field, second Rick to authorize KLJ Engineering to receive cost estimates and provide the estimates at the November regular council meeting. Motion carried.

10-09-17-05 Motion Field, second by Strom to authorize Mayor Prim and City Administrator Mike Rietz to sign the Stipulation Agreement with the MPCA. Motion carried.

10-09-17-06 Motion Rick, second Brown to approve the Task Order No. 15 with KLJ Engineering, at an estimated cost of \$5,500.00. Motion carried.

10-09-17-07 Motion Strom, second Rick to approve a Resolution appointing election judges for the November 7, 2017 election. Voted aye: Rick, Strom, Davis, Brown and Field. Absent: Goedtke. Motion carried.

10-09-17-08 Motion Strom, second Rick to approve a Resolution establishing an Election Absentee Ballot Board. Voted aye: Rick, Strom, Davis, Brown and Field. Absent: Goedtke. Motion carried. 10-09-17-09 Motion Rick, second Strom to authorize staff to sign the Joint Powers Agreement with Humboldt Township for improvements to 13th Street. Motion carried.
