SEC. 9-0101. LISTING OF UNCODED ORDINANCES IN EFFECT. All ordinances described in this Chapter remain in effect after adoption of the City Code. They are of a permanent and continuing nature as authority for a specific act which has been performed. These ordinances are of two types, that generally distinguish them from other provisions of the City Code, either (1) their texts have no continuing reference value, or (2) they are in the nature of a contract and of only occasional reference value. For these reasons it appears justified to list and describe them here only to facilitate finding them in the event this becomes necessary.

Appointment of Board to Draft City Charter

Ordinance No. 32, adopted August 14, 1897, requested the Judges of the District Court of Clay County to appoint a board of qualified legal voters of the City of Barnesville to draft a Charter for the City.

Purchase of Equipment for Sewer Cleaning

Ordinance No. 166, adopted May, 1962, provided for immediate purchase of equipment to clean out the sewers.

Fixing the Liabilities and Rates for Public Utilities for Gateway Flakes, Inc.

Ordinance No. 161, adopted May 3, 1960, fixed payment to the City of Barnesville from Gateway Flakes, Inc. for the total cost of waste disposal and water supply facilities installed by the City, retiring the capital investment in ten (10) years.

Renaming of Public Streets

Ordinance No. 206, adopted January 5, 1975, provided for the renaming of the public streets in the City.

Sewer and Water and Street Capital Replacement and Maintenance Fund

Ordinance No. 1988-3, adopted August 8, 1988, established a Sewer and Water and Street Capital Replacement and Maintenance Fund for the purpose of reconstruction, maintenance and repair of sewer and water capital improvement projects including replacement of streets due to repair of water and sewer mains.

Ward Boundaries

Ordinance No. 2002-4, adopted May 13, 2002, adopted a redistricting plan establishing ward boundaries for the City of Barnesville.

Purchase of Electric Power

Ordinance No. 168, adopted July 6, 1962, authorizes the City to enter into a contract with the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Reclamation, for the purchase of electric power.

Telephone Franchise

Ordinance No. 43, adopted May 23, 1903, granted a telephone franchise to the Wolverton and Barnsville Telephone Company, of the Town of Deerhorn, Wilkin County, Minnesota.

Ordinance No. 48, adopted June 4, 1904, granted a telephone franchise to the Rollag Telephone Company, of the Town of Park, Clay County, Minnesota.

Ordinance No. 49, adopted March 4, 1905, granted a telephone franchise to the Pelican Telephone Co. of the Village of Pelican Rapids, Otter Tail County, Minnesota.

Ordinance No. 63, adopted July 5, 1910, granted a telephone franchise to the Elkton-Barnsville Farmers' Telephone Company of Clay County, Minnesota.

Ordinance No. 64, adopted July 5, 1910, granted a telephone franchise to Manston Telephone Company of Wilkin County, Minnesota.

Ordinance No. 66, adopted June 15, 1912, granted a telephone franchise to the Humboldt Telephone Co.

Ordinance No. 83, adopted November 5, 1920, granted a telephone franchise to Altherton Co-operation Telephone Company.

Electric Franchise

Ordinance No. 171, adopted August 12, 1963, granted to Lake Region Cooperative Electric Association and Otter Tail Power Company, an electric franchise for a period of ten (10) years.

Cable TV Franchise

Ordinance No. 1980-2, adopted May 5, 1980, granted a Cable TV Franchise to Barnesville Cable TV, Inc., for a period of fifteen (15) years.

Ordinance No. 1980-3, adopted July 7, 1980, amends Ordinance No. 1980-2.

Ordinance No. 1982-9, adopted October 4, 1982, further amends Ordinance No. 1980-2.

Ordinance No. 1986-4, adopted December 8, 1986, further amends Ordinance No. 1980-2 by changing the franchisee to Valley Communications, Inc. (D/B/A Lakeland Cablevision) and changing the renewal of franchise to a period not more than fifteen (15) years.
