PUBLIC HEARING - VARIANCE FOR ADDITION TO A HOUSE AT 203 5TH ST. NW

5-5-14-03 Motion by Gott and seconded by Mortensen to open the public hearing at 6:35 p.m. Unanimously carried.

City Administrator Rietz presented the application for a variance from Mel and April Quistorff for an addition to their house at 203 5th St. NW. They had applied for a variance to encroach 10 feet into the 25-foot front yard setback. They have since indicated their desire to withdraw their request and that they will look at adding onto the back of the house instead. The Planning Commission needs to take action recommending denial of the variance to the Council because the City needs to take action on any application within 60 days, otherwise the request is deemed approved.
