

**Barnesville City Council
Special Meeting
March 28, 2016**

Mayor Gene Prim called this special meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. Members present were Council members Jason Rick, Betty Strom, Larry Davis, Jr., and Brad Field. Members absent were Council Members Dawn Stuvland and Don Goedtke. Others in attendance were City Administrator Mike Rietz, City Attorney John Shockley, City Clerk Jeri Reep, and Pam Aakre with the Record Review.

Mayor Prim stated the only item on the agenda was to discuss the sewer service line improvement bids received for 110 3rd Street SE.

City Administrator Mike Rietz informed council members that two bids were received for the repair of the sewer service line at 110 3rd Street SE. The lowest bidder was Delzer Construction of Fergus Falls in the amount of \$2,875.00. The estimated cost for the sidewalk, curb and gutter and asphalt is \$2,200.00. The agreement with Jane Larson and Leonne Lammers calls for the assessment to be for \$5,075.00 at 4.5% for 10 years. Both Jane Larson and Leonne Lammers have signed the waiver.

03-28-16-01 Motion by Mr. Rick and second by Mrs. Strom to approve the repair work at 110 3rd Street SE, not to exceed \$5,075.00 and approve the agreement of special assessment and waiver of irregularity and appeal with Jane Larson and Leonne Lammers. Lots 17 to 19 of Block 13, Original Townsite. Motion carried.

Mayor Prim adjourned the meeting at 5:07 p.m.
