## BARNESVILLE CITY COUNCIL Regular Meeting • February 12, 2018

Acting Mayor Strom called this regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Members present were Council members Don Goedtke, Betty Strom, Scott Bauer, David Brown, and Brad Field. Absent was Mayor Gene Prim and Council member Tonya Stokka

02-12-18-01 Motion Goedtke, second Brown to approve the agenda as presented with the additions of the approval of the Barnesville Rod & Gun gambling permit for February 23, 2018, and to appoint Wil Linebaugh to the Park Board. Motion carried.

02-12-18-02 Motion Field, second Bauer to approve the consent agenda. Motion carried.

02-12-18-03 Motion Goedtke, second Strom to open the public hearing at 7:02 p.m. for the vacation of an alley running west from 3rd Street SE in the Block between 4th Ave and 5th Ave. SE to a point where it intersects with the North-South alley in that same block. Motion carried.

02-12-18-04 Motion Field, second Bauer to close the public hearing at 7:06 p.m. Motion carried.

02-12-18-05 Motion Field, second Strom to approve the resolution vacating the alley running west from 3rd Street SE in the Block between 4th Ave and 5th Ave. SE to a point where it intersects with the North-South alley in that same block. Voted aye: Goedtke, Strom, Bauer, Brown, and Field. The following Voted nay: none. Absent: Prim and Stokka. Motion carried.

02-12-18-06 Motion Field, second Goedtke to approve support for the Partnership 4 health Multi-Use Path plan for the community and a Hwy 9 concept plan. Motion carried.

02-12-18-07 Motion Brown, second Goedtke to approve the Task Order No. 19 for the Wastewater Treatment Plant Secondary Cell No. 2 improvements not to exceed \$13,000.00. Motion carried.

02-12-18-08 Motion Goedtke, second Brown to authorize KLJ Engineering to submit the paperwork to get on the PFA listing for funding for the Front Street utility repairs under the MNDOT project. Motion carried.

02-12-18-09 Motion Bauer, second Goedtke to approve the 1st reading of Ordinance 2018-01 regarding Park and Recreation fees. Motion carried.

02-12-18-10 Motion Field, second Strom to authorize staff to cancel the current directory contract with the Record Review and continue to work on establishing a new contract for future directory publications. Motion carried.

02-12-18-11 Motion Brown, second Bauer to authorize staff to proceed with securing bids to provide and install an 80 panel 27.6 kw solar garden. Motion carried.

02-12-18-12 Motion Field, second Bauer to approve the Resolution setting the 2018 High-Speed Internet Speeds. Voted aye: Goedtke, Strom, Bauer, Brown and Field. Voted nay: none. Absent: Prim and Stokka. Motion carried.

02-12-18-13 Motion Bauer, second Goedtke to approve the Resolution setting the 2018 Cable TV Rates. Voted aye: Goedtke, Strom, Bauer, Brown and Field. Voted nay: none. Absent: Prim and Stokka. Motion carried.

# BARNESVILLE CITYWIDE CLEAN UP WEEK APRIL 18, 19 AND 20, 2018

**\*\*\* DISPOSE OF YOUR OLD TV'S, COMPUTERS and COMPUTER MONITORS \*\*\***  
**NO Curbside Pick-up BUT - FREE RESIDENTIAL ELECTRONICS COLLECTION**  
**SATURDAY, APRIL 21 from 8 AM - 12 NOON - Barnesville Recycling Center**

- **SPECIAL GARBAGE AND BUILDING DEBRIS PICK UP** on Wednesday, April 18, Thursday, April 19 and Friday, April 20. All material must be set out by 5:00 a.m.

**IMPORTANT - Each Resident is limited to putting out 10 Cubic Yards of Material, This is roughly a pile that is 6 FEET WIDE, 15 FEET LONG and 3 FEET HIGH.**

- **WEDNESDAY, APRIL 18** all residential customers who have their garbage collected on Wednesday will also receive the special spring clean up, pick up of garbage, and small amounts of building debris.
- **THURSDAY, APRIL 19** all residential customers East of Front Street and North of and including 3rd Ave. SE will receive the special spring clean up, pick up of garbage, and small amounts of building debris.
- **FRIDAY, APRIL 20** residential customers East of Front Street and South of 3rd Ave. SE (excluding 3rd Ave. SE) will receive the special spring clean up, pick up of garbage, and small amounts of building debris. *If time allows, the crew will work ahead of the above schedule, but will do the entire route on the stated day and time.*
- **DURING THIS WEEK ONLY**, garbage and building debris will be collected at your normal garbage collection pick up location. **NO ADDITIONAL TAGS ARE NEEDED FOR THIS SPECIAL CLEAN UP WEEK.** Garbage and building debris are to be piled separately and in manageable piles or they will not be picked up!
- **THERE WILL NOT BE CURBSIDE PICK UP OF TIRES.** You may dispose of car and pickup tires at the recycling center upon payment of a \$2.50 fee per tire. \*The rims must be removed before bringing them in. The recycling center will take tires all year during open hours at the same fee. *Please note you must pay this fee at the recycling center.*
- **IMPORTANT APPLIANCE INFORMATION:** Appliances can always be disposed of at the recycling center upon payment of a \$20 fee. During the special three days of Spring Clean Up, appliances will be collected at your residence after payment of the \$20.00 fee at the recycling center. Your name will be put on a list and appliances will be picked up periodically during the week. Regular hours at the recycling center are Tuesdays and Thursdays, noon to 8:00 p.m. and Saturdays 8:00 am. to noon.
- **HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE:** Special Barnesville Collection at Clay County Shop, NW of Dollar General from 8 am to Noon on Saturday, April 21. Paint, stains and varnishes, cleaners, cements and adhesives, paint thinners and strippers, pesticides and herbicides and used motor oil and filters

**THE YARD WASTE SITE LOCATED SOUTHWEST OF THE CITY SHOP NEAR LAGOONS** are now open for the 2018 season and will remain open daily for the season.
