- 07-08-19-01 Motion by Mrs. Stokka and second by Mrs. Stuvland to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried.
- 07-08-19-02 Motion by Mr. Goedtke and seconded by Mrs. Stuvland to approve the consent agenda as presented. Motion carried.
- 07-08-19-03 Motion by Mr. Bauer and second by Mr. Goedtke to approve the CUP at 203 9th Street SE, with the conditions set forth in the CUP. Motion approved.

**FLUSHING OF WATER MAINS**  
**SEPTEMBER 16-30**

North West Services will be flushing water mains from Sept. 16-30. This process may cause some temporary discoloration of your water. To remove the discoloration, turn on several faucets in or outside your home or business, and leave the water run until it clears.

**NEW WARRANTY PROGRAM**

The City of Barnesville has entered into a partnership agreement with **Service Line Warranties of America** making a warranty program available to help residents cover the repair costs associated with water and sewer service lines.

While the City covers the cost to repair water and sewer "mains", homeowners are responsible for any repair costs for the service lines that run from the mains to the house. These costs are not necessarily covered by your homeowners insurance policy.

Recently you should have received a letter from this company outlining the programs being offered.

The program is voluntary for homeowners and no public funds are used to promote or administer the program. If residents have any questions, they should contact the company directly. If there are concerns, please contact City Hall at 354.2292.
