## **Rules and Regulations**

- 1. The planting season will start on May 1<sup>st</sup> (weather permitting) and all plots must be cleared by October 20<sup>th</sup>.
- 2. If you decide not to use your plot, please notify Midwest Bank at 218-354-2704. There are no refunds on plot fees paid.
- 3. Gardeners are responsible for maintenance of their plot. If your plot is overgrown with weeds, you will receive a warning. If there is no action taken within one week, your plot may be moved and reassigned.
- 4. There is a hose available for use. Please ensure the hose is put back neatly and water is turned off after use.
- 5. Gardeners will need to bring their own gardening tools. All tools need to be taken home each day.
- 6. Plots are to be used for vegetables and flowers. Growing trees, shrubs, or perennials is prohibited.
- 7. The garden shed is not for your personal use and is the property of the Barnesville Community Garden.
- 8. Only access your garden via the grass. Please do not walk into other gardens.
- 9. Please park along the street and walk to your plot. Do not drive onto the grass. Access garden via 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave SW.
- 10. Gardeners are responsible to dispose of their weeds. No compost disposal on site, but there is a composite pile located to the West of the city shop.
- 11. Use of herbicide sprays (weed killers) is not allowed.
- 12. Pets are not allowed in the garden area at any time.
- 13. Use of tobacco products or consumption of alcohol in the garden is not allowed.
