Mayor Rick called this regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Member's present were Council members Brad Field, Tonya Stokka, Alyssa Bergman, Dawn Stuvland, Scott Bauer, and Don Goedtke.

07-12-21-01 Motion Stuvland, second Bergman to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried.

07-12-21-02 Motion Stokka, second Stuvland to approve the consent agenda as presented.

07-12-21-03 Motion Field, second Stuvland to approve to sell two parcels of property to Mr. Cris Mortensen for a total of \$400.00, and to execute the purchase agreement and quit claim deed for the sale of the property, contingent upon Mr. Mortensen's grant loans with the city to be paid in full prior to the sale of property. Motion carried.

07-12-21-04 Motion Bauer, second Goedtke to deny the variance request at 805 11th Ave SE. Motion carried.

07-12-21-05 Motion Goedtke, second Stuvland to approve the variance request at 550 10th Street NE for Ryan Hauck. Motion carried.

07-12-21-06 Motion Stuvland, second Goedtke to approve the CUP request from the Barnesville EDA, Barnesville Commercial Park 4th Addition, excluding the north 195 feet of Block 3, Lot 7, Barnesville Commercial Park 4th Addition. Motion carried.

07-12-21-07 Motion Goedtke, second Stokka to approve the lot split for the north 195 feet of Block 3, Lot 7 in the Barnesville Commercial Park Fourth Addition. Motion carried.

07-12-21-08 Motion Bauer, second Stokka to approve the resolution accepting the offer on the sale of \$1,135,000 General Obligation tax abatement bonds, Series 2021A. Voted aye: Stokka, Goedtke, Stuvland, Bauer, Bergman, and Field. Absent: none. Motion carried. Approved at 7:36 p.m.

07-12-21-09 Motion Bauer, second Stokka to approve the Resolution accepting offer on the sale of \$1,305,000 General Obligation Improvement and Refunding Bonds, Series 2021B. Voted aye: Stokka, Goedtke, Stuvland, Bauer, Bergman, and Field. Absent: none. Motion carried. Approved at 7:37 p.m.

07-12-21-10 Motion Stuvland, second Field to authorize staff to advertise for a water/wastewater technician. Motion carried.

07-12-21-11 Motion Field, second Stuvland to approve the Resolution setting the 2021 high speed internet speed and rates. Voted aye: Stokka, Goedtke, Stuvland, Bauer, Bergman and Field. Voted nay: none. Motion carried.

BARNESVILLE CITY COUNCIL
Emergency Meeting • July 20, 2021

Mayor Rick called this emergency meeting to order at 7:31 a.m. Member's present were Council members Brad Field, Tonya Stokka (by telephone), Alyssa Bergman, Dawn Stuvland, Scott Bauer, and Don Goedtke.

07-20-21-01 Motion Field, second Goedtke to declare a Stage 3 water restrictions with the following parameters:

- No turf watering except for newly seeded lawns;
- Even numbered homes can water trees, shrubs, and gardens with hand held devices only from 6:00 a.m. until 9:00 a.m. and from 7:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m. on even numbered calendar days and odd numbered house can do the same on odd numbered calendar days;
- The city's splash pad hours are limited to 2:00 p.m. until 5:00 p.m. and water volumes will also be reduced.
- The filling of swimming pools and washing of vehicles is prohibited.

Motion carried unanimously.

There being no additional business, Mayor Rick adjourned the meeting at 8:11 a.m.
