Mayor Rick called this regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Member's present were Council members Tonya Stokka, Don Goedtke, Scott Bauer, and Brad Field. Absent were Council members Dawn Stuvland and Alyssa Bergman.

- 07-08-24-01 Motion Stokka, second Bergman to approve the agenda as presented, with the removal of the Potato Days liquor request from the consent agenda to the council business.
- 07-08-24-02 Motion Stokka, second Bergman to approve the consent agenda as presented. Motion carried.
- 07-08-24-03 Motion Goedtke, second Bauer to approve the CUP request from Farmers Coop Oil Company, 619 Front Street North. Motion carried.
- 07-08-24-04 Motion Stokka, second Goedtke to approve the alcohol permits for the August 6, 2024 block parties. Motion carried.
- 07-08-24-05 Motion Bauer, second Stokka to recommend to the League of MN Cities to approve the bid from Minnesota Exteriors Commercial in the amount of \$100,823.61 for the asphalt shingle bid, and \$230,820.90 for the metal roof/siding bid. Motion carried.
