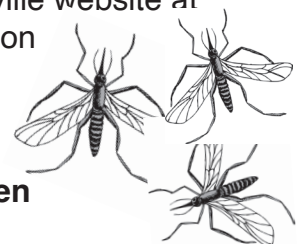

Regular Meeting • April 8 , 2024**

Regular City Council Meetings are held the second Monday of every month beginning at 7:00 pm in the City Council Chambers located at the rear of City Hall. The public are welcome. The agenda is posted on the City's website and Facebook page.

Mayor Rick called this regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Member's present were Council members Tonya Stokka, Alyssa Bergman, Don Goedtke, Dawn Stuvland, and Brad Field. Absent was Council member Scott Bauer.

- 04-08-24-01 Motion Stuvland, second Stokka to approve the agenda, with the removal of the FFA signage installation on the consent agenda. Motion carried.
- 04-08-24-02 Motion Stokka, second Bergman to approve the consent agenda, with the removal of the installation of FFA signage from the consent agenda. Motion carried
- 04-08-24-03 Motion Field, second Goedtke to approve the MRES-Barnesville Distribution System Operations and Maintenance Agreement. Motion carried.
- 04-08-24-04 Motion Goedtke, second Stuvland to approve the quote from Treatment Resources for the purchase of a water treatment plant filter in the amount of \$154,870.00. Motion carried.
- 04-08-24-05 Motion Stuvland, seconded Stokka to purchase the 2024 Ford ambulance from Premier Specialty in Fergus Falls, MN for a total delivered price of \$174,900.00. Motion carried.
- 04-08-24-06 Motion Stokka, second Field to approve the resolution to increase the Cable TV rates. Voted aye: Stokka, Goedtke, Stuvland, Bergman and Field. Absent: Bauer. Motion carried.
- 04-08-24-07 Motion Goedtke, second Field to approve to use Council discretionary funds for a light meal at the Event Center on May 13, 2024, not to exceed \$4,750.00. Motion carried.

Mayor Rick adjourned the meeting at 7:42 p.m.

The Minnesota Pollution Control Agency recently recognized Barnesville for operational excellence in 2023. To receive this award, facilities must demonstrate consistent compliance with monitoring, operations, and maintenance requirements, as well as submitting accurate, on-time reports to the MPCA.

Of the approximately 1,600 municipal and industrial wastewater facilities in Minnesota, only 253 qualified for this recognition.
