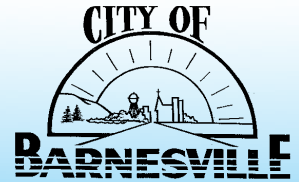

Regular Meeting • April 14, 2025

Regular City Council Meetings are held the second Monday of every month beginning at 6:30 pm in the City Council Chambers located at the rear of City Hall. The public are welcome. The agenda is posted on the City's website and Facebook page.

Mayor Rick called this regular meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Member's present were Council members Don Goedtke, Alyssa Bergman, Tonya Stokka, and Brad Field. Absent were Council members Dawn Stuvland and Scott Bauer.

04-14-25-01 Motion Stokka, second Goedtke to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried.

04-14-25-02 Motion Bergman, second Goedtke to approve the consent agenda as presented. Motion carried.

04-14-25-03 Motion Goedtke, second Field to approve the Small Cities Local Government Resolution. Upon a roll call vote, motion carried.

04-14-25-04 Motion Bergman, second Stokka to approve the Small Cities Slum & Blight Resolution. Upon a roll call vote, motion carried.

04-14-25-05 Motion Goedtke, second Bergman to approve the petition for vacation of the platted right-of-way for 7th street SW, in the McGrath's 2nd Addition, in the city of Barnesville, County of Clay, Minnesota, and also to vacate any portion of any Right-of-Way or public easement within the property described and shown as TRACT 1, Auditor's Outlot 25-G to the City of Barnesville, excepting there from the three tracts. Motion to set the public hearing date of May 12, 2025, at 6:30 p.m. Motion carried.

04-14-25-06 Motion Field, second Stokka to allow the Barnesville Food Shelf to use the Event Center for the youth summer lunch program from May-August 2025. Motion carried.

04-14-25-07 Motion Stokka, second Bergman to approve the 2nd reading of Ordinance 2025-03, an ordinance regarding park fees. Motion carried.

04-14-25-08 Motion Field, second Stokka to deny the variance request from Cynthia Olson, 202 3rd Ave. SE. Motion carried.

04-14-25-09 Motion Field, second Stokka to approve the seal coat bid from Asphalt Preservation Co, in the amount of \$141,000.08. Motion carried.

04-14-25-10 Motion Field, second Bergman to approve the bid from Paul Communications, in the amount of \$10,000.00 plus shipping for the Cable TV Head End equipment, and SD and HD cable boxes. Motion carried.

Mayor Rick adjourned the meeting at 7:01 p.m.
